



Our Heron View service has been supporting HMPPS and Justice Teams to transition prisoners from HM Prisons and Service Users from NHS England secure hospitals nationally since it opened three years ago.

WHAT WE DELIVER:

- Robust risk management
- 24 hour nursing care if needed
- Person-centred approach with a focus on recovery and independence
- Customised support and care plans

WHO WE SUPPORT:

- Adult males (18+) who have offended or who are at risk of offending
- Individuals managed by MAPPA, Jigsaw and other agencies
- Individuals stepping down from HM Prisons and secure hopsital settings
- Aggression & challenging behaviour
- Sexual disinhibition
- Risk to themselves and/or others

INDIVIDUAL'S NEEDS:

- Multiple and complex needs
- Mental Illness diagnosis
- Mild Learning Disabilities (Mental Health being main diagnosis)
- Personality Disorder diagnosis
- Physical and health needs
- Neurological diagnosis i.e Dementia, Huntington's, Korsakoff & Alzheimer's Disease
- Acquired brain injury/ traumatic brain injury
- Individuals from Prison, secure hospital, step down services or broken down placements

SOUTH LONDON

HERON VIEW:

35 bedded service for Males 18+, supporting older person cohort (with new supported accommodation close by, opening in autumn).



NIGHTINGALES:

9 bedded service for Males 18+, supporting more working age cohort

CASE STUDY:

Mr X came to Heron View in 2020 and prior to his placement with us he was based at HMP Thameside Prison in London. His placement team had identified that Mr X needed a specialist Residential Care Home that could support his ongoing Mental Health needs and Neurocognitive Disorder.

When Mr X arrived at Heron View he settled into the service within his first week and the team had a already set out a robust risk management and care plan that would support him while in the service. Mr X now considers Heron View

as his home and enjoys planning and discussing how he intends to live his life in a least restrictive setting with the full support of his dedicated team.

Mr X now actively engages with the daily activities that take place at the service and in the community such as table tennis, football, bingo, music class and gardening. Mr X is very happy at Heron View and is always thanking staff for supporting him in his new environment and offering him the tools and care to live out a meaningful and happy life.
