

Fairlight Female Acute Unit

The Langford Centre, Fairlight Acute Unit offers an extension to NHS acute services during times of fluctuating demand and bed pressures.

The service supports up to fifteen female Service Users in a purpose-built environment with en-suite bedrooms and direct access to outside private garden space. The unit benefits from its own entrance and access away from the main hospital and allows for emergency admissions to take place from a secure access point.

2 REVIEW SERVICE USER

We aim to assess and confirm suitability within two hours of the referral form and accompanying clinical documentation being received.

3 CONFIRM SUITABILITY

We will confirm suitability for admission and the Service User can only be admitted to the service once a completed and signed funding form has been received.

4 ADMIT SERVICE USER

Admission is confirmed and arranged with the referral team and the clinical team at Fairlight Ward.

We can support referrals Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30am and 5pm. Our service works towards a two-hour turnaround time for all referrals needing an acute admission.



WHO WE SUPPORT

- FEMALE 18+
- REQUIRES ACUTE HOSPITAL ADMISSION FOR ASSESSMENT OR TREATMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH DISORDER
- CAN HAVE COMPLEX NEEDS / CHALLENGING BEHAVIOURS
- CAN BE INFORMAL AND CAN ALSO BE DETAINED UNDER CIVIL SECTIONS OF THE MHA (PART 2 OF THE ACT).
- CAN HAVE OFFENCE RELATED BEHAVIOURS OR AN ESTABLISHED FORENSIC HISTORY
