

Mental Health Acute Services

The Langford Centre offers an extension to NHS Acute Services during times of fluctuating demand and bed pressures.

The service supports up to sixteen female and fifteen male Service Users in a purpose-built environment with en-suite bedrooms and direct access to outside private garden space. The units benefit from their own entrance and access away from the main hospital and allows for emergency admissions to take place from a secure access point.

2 REVIEW SERVICE USER

We aim to assess and confirm suitability within two hours of the referral form and accompanying clinical documentation being received.

3 CONFIRM SUITABILITY

We will confirm suitability for admission and the Service User can only be admitted to the service once a completed and signed funding form has been received.

4 ADMIT SERVICE USER

Admission is confirmed and arranged with the referral team and the clinical team at The Langford Centre.

We can support referrals Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30am and 5pm. Our service works towards a two-hour turnaround time for all referrals needing an acute admission.
